1. Information on how to enter and prizes for the "Light Microscopy Australia Micrograph Competition" ("Competition") form part of these ("Terms and Conditions"). Entry into the Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Competition commences for entry submissions at 9am ADST on Friday 25th November 2016. **Entries close 5pm ADST on Wednesday 25th January 2017.** No late entries will be accepted.
3. Entry is only open to current members of Light Microscopy of Australia. **Each entrant may submit a maximum of THREE images.** Members of the public, agencies or companies are ineligible to enter.
4. To enter, you must submit one or more (max. of three) images that have been taken using a transmitted light or fluorescence microscope. Your image(s) must be sent electronically by email together with this completed entry form to **Dr Pamela Young (pamela.young@sydney.edu.au)** by the closing date of the Competition.
5. The image file format for emailing submissions can be TIFF or PDF. Image files should be high resolution with a recommended file size equal to or greater than 3-4MB.
6. All valid entries will be displayed in the Charles Perkins Centre Hub with entrant's name, title of entry and a brief image description (time and date to be confirmed).
7. Each entry must be the original work of the person entering the competition and all entrants agree that their entry does not contain any material that infringes anyone else's copyright.
8. Light Microscopy Australia accepts no responsibility for lost, late, stolen, damaged or misdirected entries.
9. Each entrant grants Light Microscopy Australia the right to reproduce, publish, transmit or otherwise communicate to the public their entry, in whole or in part, in or using any media for any purpose without permission or payment.
10. All valid entries received by 5pm on Wednesday 25th January 2017 will be individually judged by a panel appointed by Light Microscopy Australia who, at their discretion, will select images for display and of these the **best entries will be selected as prize winners.**
11. The winner(s) of this Competition will win ONE of the fabulous prizes kindly donated by the sponsors.
12. Selected entrants, including the prize winners will be notified by email that their images are to be displayed and if they are one of the prize winners by mid-February 2017. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence, including in the event of a dispute, will be entered into.
13. All entries will be judged having regard to the overall aesthetics of the image, technical difficulty in obtaining the image, research relevance, originality and suitability for the competition.
14. The prize is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
